

## AWARENESS PROGRAM ON DENGUE PREVENTION & CONTROL

Center for Catalyzing Community (CCC) partnering with National Vector Borne Disease Control Program (NVBDCP) and Dist Rotary 3262 launched an Awareness Program to fight Dengue on 12.10.2015. The primary objective of the campaign was to spread awareness amongst communities and to reach out to the larger sections of the society.

Considering the pressing health emergency of dengue facing our nation right now, (CCC) Center of Catalyzing Community, Bhubaneswar, National Vector Borne Disease Control Program (NVBDCP) and Dist Rotary 3262 launched a Dengue Awareness Program in Bhingarpur M.E School, Bhingarpur Panchayat, Balihanta Block on 12.10.2015. Where Sarpanch of Bhingarpur, Aganwadi Workers, Ashakarmi Workers, School Teacher and Villagers were Present around 105 Participated in this Program. The program was launched with the main objective of spreading awareness on prevention and control of dengue amongst Villagers. There are certain diseases which unfortunately neither have the control nor the ability to limit their spread. However, dengue as a disease is one, which can be controlled with certain preventive and precautionary measures. Therefore, the Program aimed to move forward with spreading awareness as its primary objective. And talk by a technical expert followed by an interactive session which provided a platform where People could clear their queries.

### Introductory Speech: -



**Mrs. Niharika Mishra**, Secretary/Chief Functionary (CCC) had delivered a warm welcome address where she had shown her special gratitude towards Villager of Bhingarpur, and kept One Mintue Silent invocation was held for CCC President Late Pusparani Mohapatra. In her speech she had put importance upon the fact that “not like mosquitoes that transmit Malaria, mosquitoes that transmit Dengue lay their eggs in small man-made containers filled with Contaminated water. This means that without individual household efforts to eradicate these breeding sites it is not possible to effectively control the spread of dengue. Individual effort to control the mosquitoes is necessary to prevent and control the spread of dengue in the community. At the same time, community action can provide support to individuals to keep their household’s mosquito free.”- She said.

**Objective of the Awareness Programme: -**

The main objective of the program was to educate Villager of Bhingarpur about Dengue and its prevention and control.

**Resource Person: -**

Mr. Charu Chandra Mahapatra (IEC Consultant, NVBDCP and Mr. Dipti Ranjan Mahapatra (Asst:Unit Officer, NVBDCP were Guest of Honour , Both of them deeply elaborated the prevention & Control on Dengue



The programme methodology focused on:-

- Building the Villagers potential through knowledge and awareness for Dengue Prevention & Control.
- Interacting with participants on Aedes Mosquitoes
- Digestion period for absorbing information and for participants to speak about what they have learnt and Programme experience-sharing



- Prevalence of Dengue in India & Orissa
- Type of Dengue - signs & symptoms of Dengue Fever, DHF and Dengue Shock Syndrome
- Vector & host of Dengue – type of mosquitoes; transmission of infection
- Actions to be taken to prevent & control Dengue
- The level of community knowledge and awareness about Dengue Prevention & control.
- The scope of information dissemination and awareness generation about Dengue prevention & control at RWAs.

**Mr. Sibabrata Dash Dist. Governor, Rotary 3262, Chief Speaker** has given a valuable Speech to the Villager about “Fight Dengue” and prevention & Control.



He has shared his experience and Knowledge with the Villager. The start of the session was such that each and every participant got completely involved in it and the environment was same till end of the speech.
